

## Security of supply: Data provision for Ukrainian storage facilities temporarily suspended as of 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022

Following the request of Ukrtransgaz, individual data provision for Ukrainian storage facilities has been temporarily suspended as of 03/03/2022. An aggregated dataset covering all Ukrainian storages is expected to return on AGSI+
