



All interested stakeholders are invited to participate at the joint workshop on Guarantees of Origin ('GO') of 'renewable and low-carbon gases' organised by ENTSOG and GIE on 7 May 2019, from 10:00 to 17:00 at GIE/ENTSOG premises in Brussels.

At the European Commission's 31st Madrid Forum in October 2018, it was broadly acknowledged that 'renewable and low-carbon gases' will play a significant and growing role in the energy transition. GIE and ENTSOG are developing a set of recommendations for an EU-wide GO scheme for such gases in consultation with Prime Movers group. Our current thinking on this topic will be presented to participant stakeholders at this Workshop and we would welcome your feedback on this topic at the event. The results will be submitted to the upcoming Madrid Forum in June 2019.
